July 5th, 12th, 19th and 26th will start at 10:00am.**

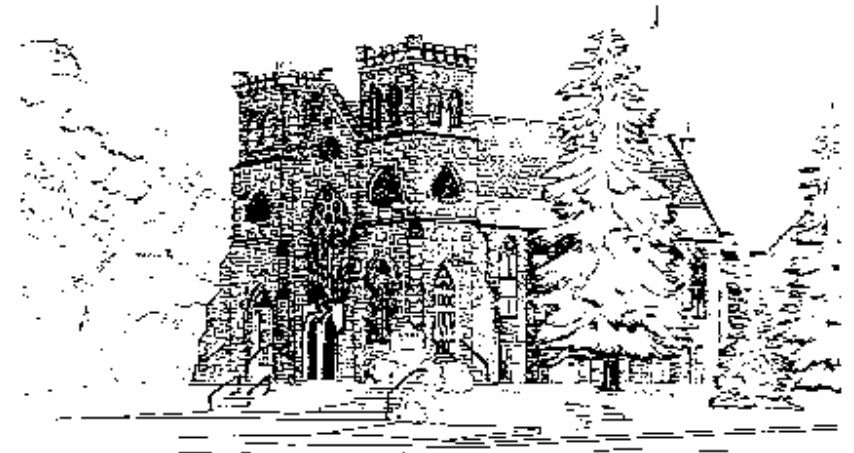
