The Congregational Life would like to clarify that the PlainFare Luncheon donation has gone to Missions. This event was started by our good friend HanK Van Goch who is truly missed.

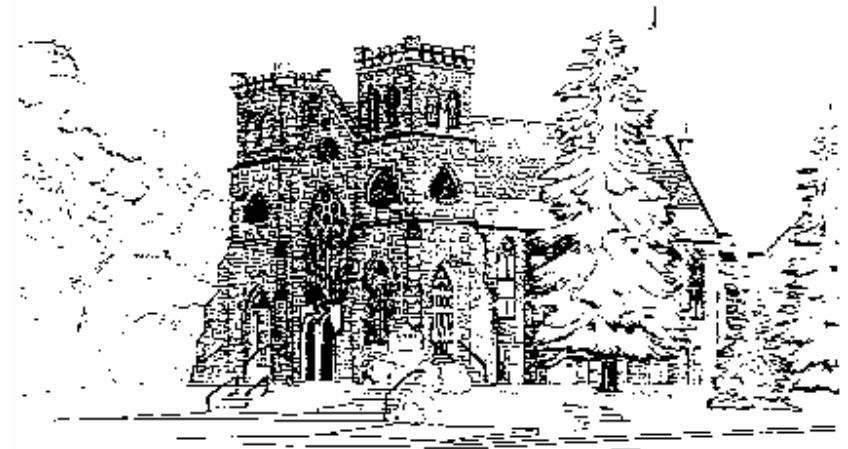
