### Camp Knox is going on a HIGH SEAS ADVENTURE August 16th to 20th from 9:00 am to 12:00 noon

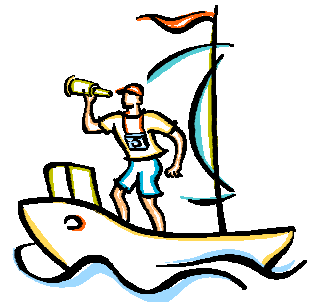
