You will often hear the term Presbyterian Sharing. Presbyterian Sharing is the fund that supports the national programs and ministries of the PCC. Presbyterians are sharing in a wide range of ministries: working with mission partners overseas and supporting mission and ministry in Canada.

The fund is supported by gifts from congregations. This fund supports the work of the Life and Mission Agency and its departments: International Ministries, Canada Ministries, Justice Ministries, Ministry and Church Vocations, Education for Discipleship, and Communication. It also includes the work of the General Assembly, Financial Support Services and the theological colleges in Montreal, Toronto, and Vancouver.

Without this fund we could not train ministers, support missionaries around the world, work for justice in the social aspects of society, educate elders and leaders of the church, ensure good training in colleges for our ministers, support the establishment of new congregations in Canada, and so many more areas that effect the support of the Presbyterian Church in Canada and around the world.

Our support for Presbyterian Sharing is a vital link in the ongoing mission of God's work through our denomination. As Christians we have a spiritual and moral obligation to work for Christ in all aspects of life. Presbyterian Sharing gives each of us a wonderful way to be ministers of love in a tangible way and ensures the continued success of God's work in Canada and around the world.
