Food Bank Box at the rear of the sanctuary is emptied the first week of every month. Please remember those less fortunate.

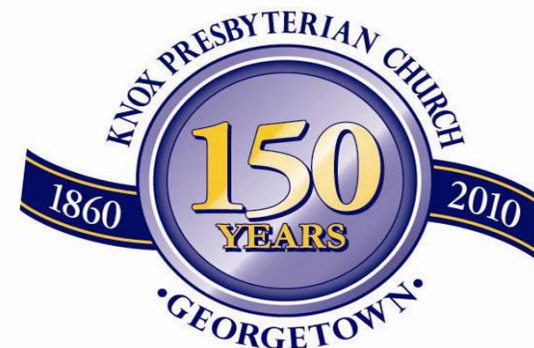
